

## English

Over the term in English we will be looking at recount writing linked to the book 'Quest' by Aaron Becker. We will then apply the skills we have learned by writing recounts of our Roman day for the school website.

Then we will be looking at a text linked to our Romans topic called 'Escape from Pompeii' and be writing diary entries from the perspective of a Roman.

## Creative curriculum

Our new topic for the whole of spring term is the Rocking Romans. We will be researching and learning about the daily lives of the romans in terms of; food, clothing, homes, jobs, gods etc...

Not only will our creative curriculum feed into our English and maths, but into our art and DT too. For art we will be studying the romans' use of mosaics in their architecture. In DT we will be making our own miniature roman chariots.
