

English

Over the term in English we will be looking at dairy entries, linked to our creative curriculum topic the Rocking Romans, thinking about the lives of the roman people. We will also be looking at myths and legends and writing some of our own. In addition to this we will be looking at non-chronological reports, again linked to our romans topic.

For the second half of the spring term we will be learning about biographies and autobiographies, researching and writing about some of the children's heroes. In addition to this, we will look at poetry around an Easter theme.

Creative curriculum

Our new topic for the whole of spring term is the Rocking Romans. We will be researching and learning about the daily lives of the romans in terms of; food, clothing, homes, jobs, gods etc...

Not only will our creative curriculum feed into our English and maths, but into our art and DT too. For art we will be studying the romans' use of mosaics in their architecture. In DT we will be making our own miniature roman chariots.
