

# Vernham Dean Gillum's Pupil Premium Statement 2015 – 2016

*'The Pupil Premium is additional funding for publicly funded schools in England to raise the attainment of disadvantaged pupils and close the gap between them and their peers.'*

The Pupil Premium provides funding for pupils:

- In receipt of free school meals (FSM) at any point in the past 6 years (£935 per child)
- Parents are currently serving in the armed forces, or whose parent/carer is in receipt of a pension from the MoD (£300 per child)
- In Local Authority care for 1 day or more in (£1900 per child)
- Adopted from care under the Adoption and Children Act 2002 or who have left care under a Special Guardianship or Residence Order (£1,900)

Through our vision we are committed to every child achieving their personal best. Our key aim for our pupil premium children is to support and accelerate progress through early identification and intervene appropriately. Through this, we aim to unlock the potential in all children to achieve our school vision.

## **Key objectives**

- To ensure the performance of disadvantaged pupils at the end of KS2 remains high and the gap remains closed
- To provide early interventions to narrow the gap between disadvantaged pupils and other pupils in KS1
- To provide a range of opportunities for pupils, no matter what their background, to access learning opportunities outside the classroom
- To provide targeted interventions, particularly to develop reading and writing, for identified pupils
- To ensure families of disadvantaged pupils are engaged with school
- To provide Emotional Literacy Support so that children can access learning more successfully
